

Policies of Health and Hygiene Subcommittee

- Adequate classroom space to avoid crowding.
- Classrooms with adequate daylight and ventilation.
- The provision of safe water for drinking and personal hygiene is important and there needs to be adequate facilities in proportion to the number of students.
- Latrines should be hygienic to use and easy to clean. Students themselves should participate in daily cleaning of the latrine. The health and hygiene committee should take the leading role in the maintenance of latrine cleanliness.
- Waste bins/buckets in each classroom and teacher's office. Waste bins may be placed in the college compound where deemed necessary.
- Overcrowding must be controlled as much as possible. Overcrowding leads to the transmission of many communicable diseases.
- The committee is also looking forward to arranging a stretcher and a wheel chair under emergency health situations.
- Waste including e-waste, paper, bio-hazard etc collected by the vital waste company would be reviewed intermittently and reports should be documented.
