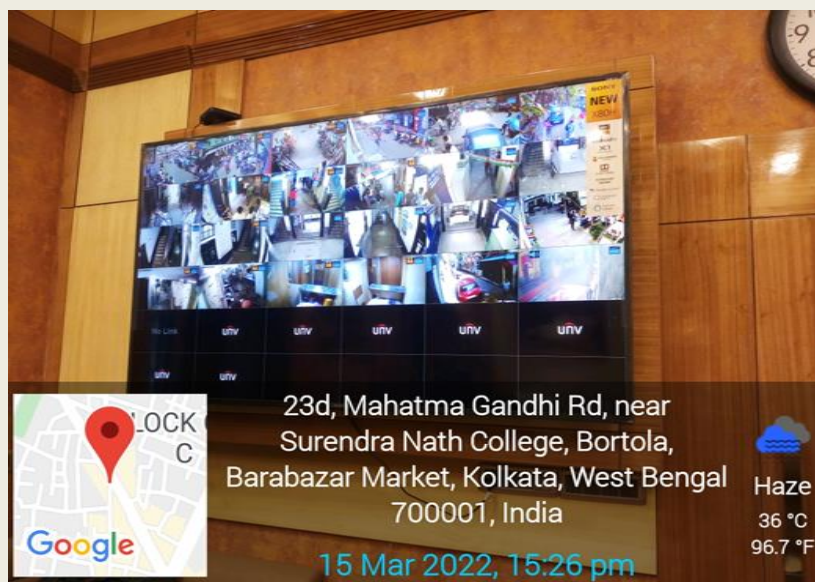

Girl students are highly secured under the existing security system. CCTVs are installed at the entrance of the college gate, canteen, parking area, office, corridors of different floors of the College to ensure the safety and security of students and staff. ID cards are issued to the students and staff to prevent the entry of outsiders into the college premises.

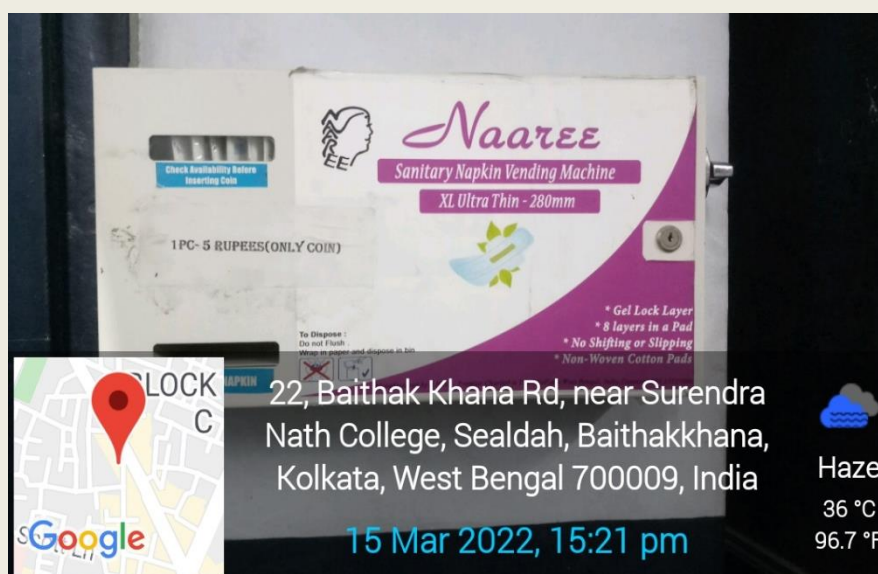


Common room facilities are available in the Institution. The common room helps build a sense of community and provide girl students the facilities to study, have informal discussions in free time available, socialise and for recreation.

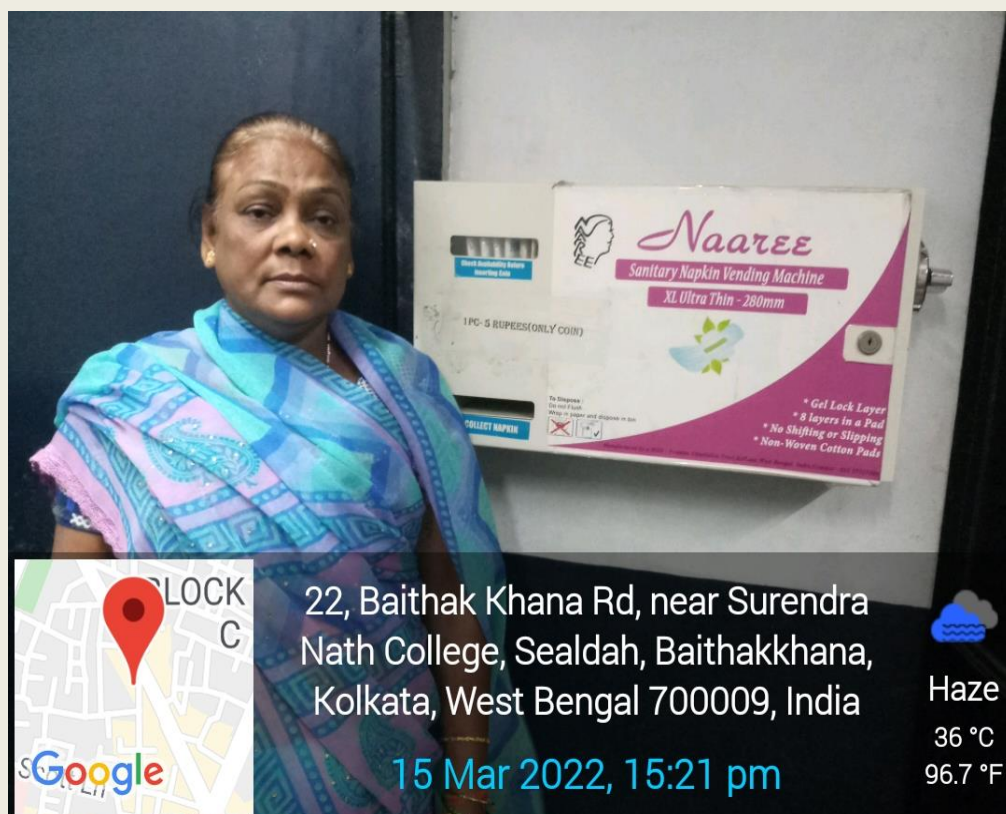
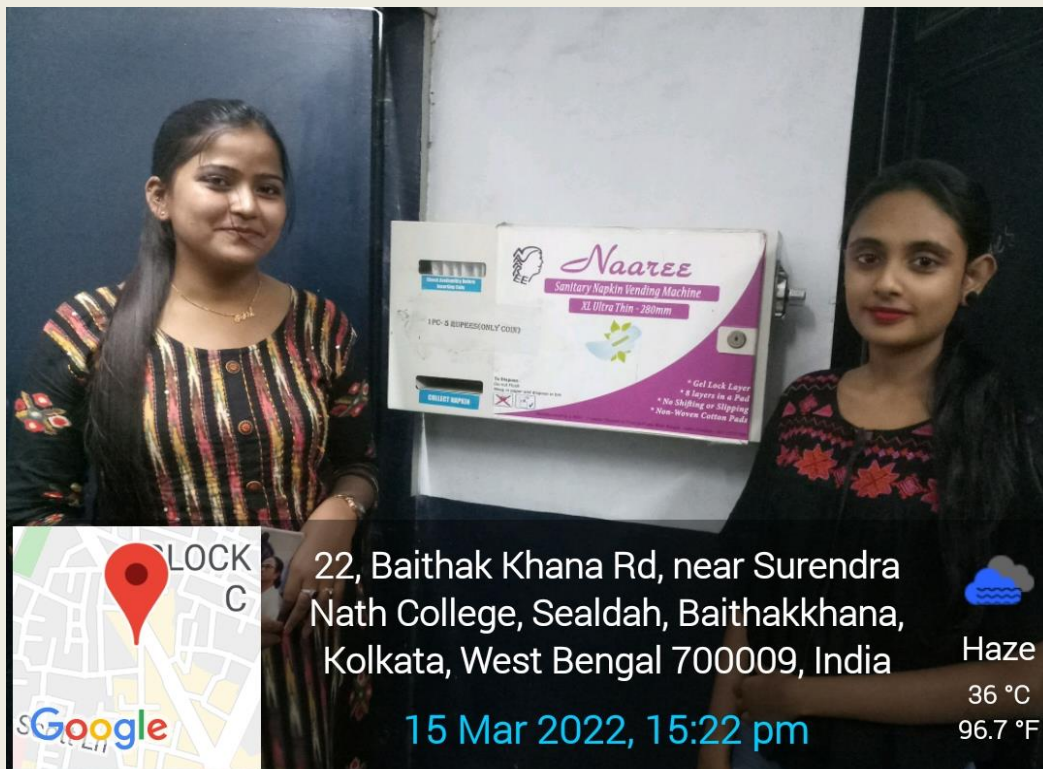


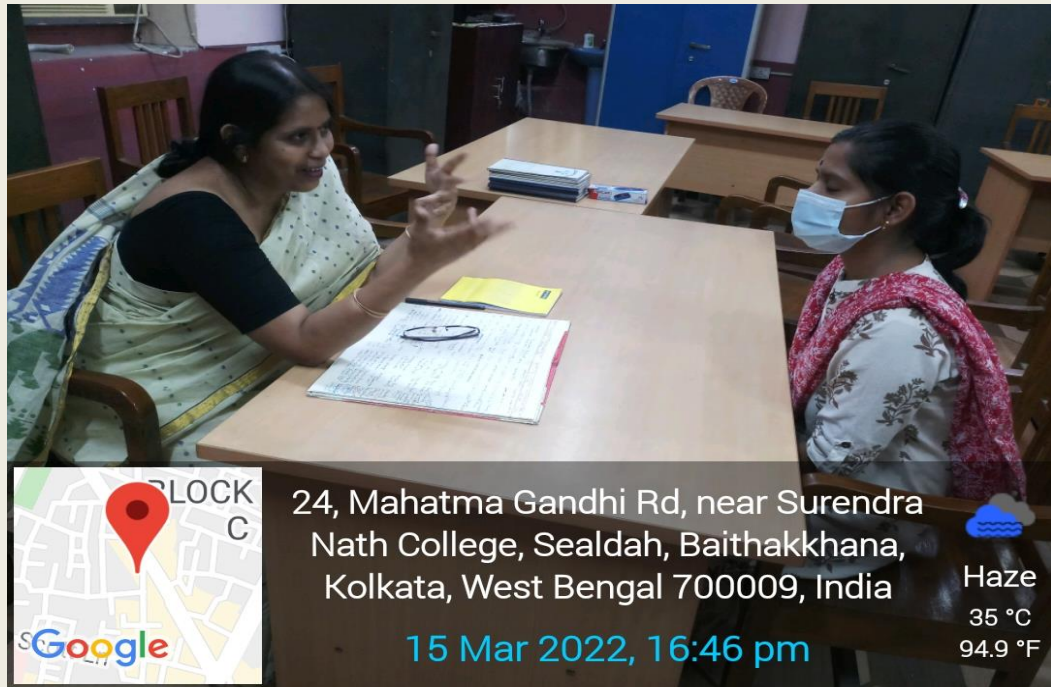


Every floor has a separate functional toilet for men and a separate toilet for women.



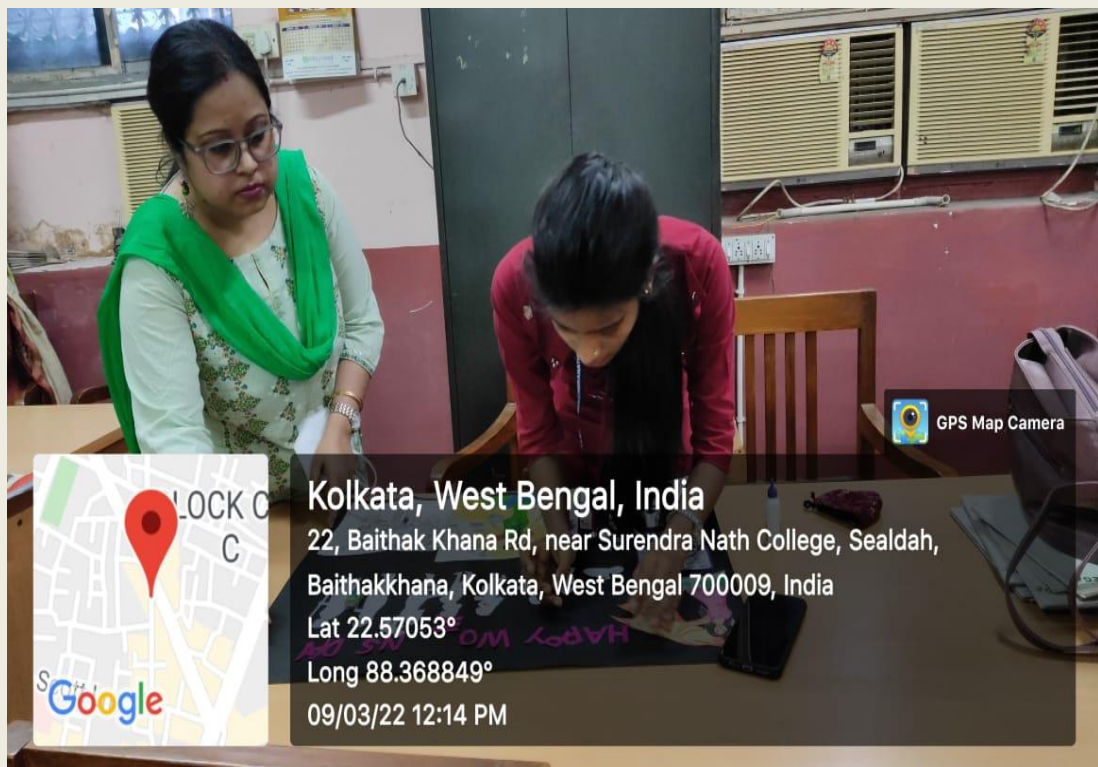
The woman Cell has installed for the girl students at this institute Sanitary napkin Vending Machine at a very low cost.

Security guards are deployed at main gate and students with valid identity cards are allowed into the campus.



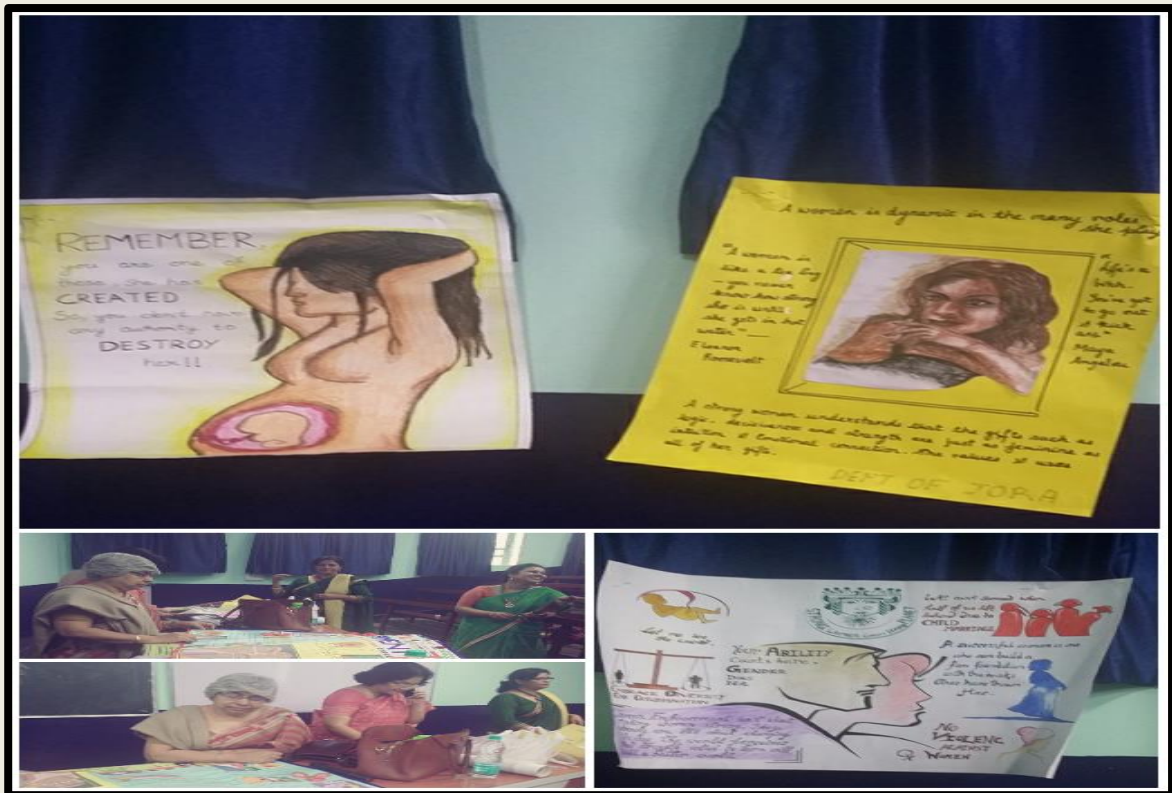
Seminar on Women, Violence and Rights.

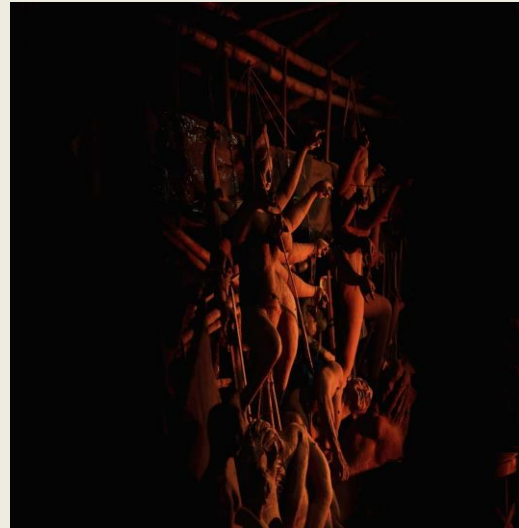




Women cell organised international women's Day by arranging a poster competition on Women Empowerment that followed by a cultural program



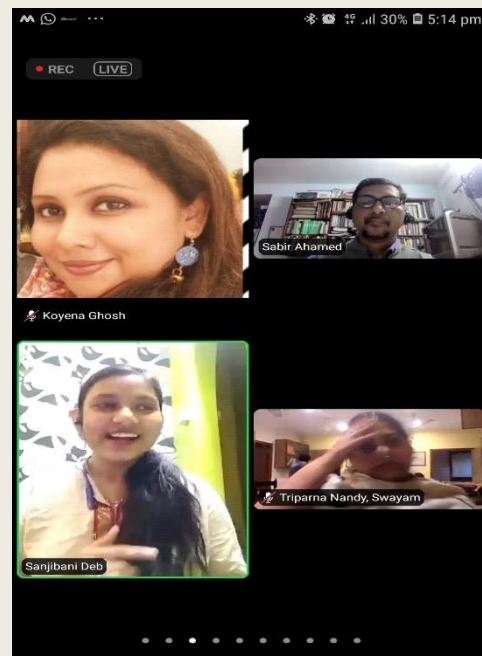

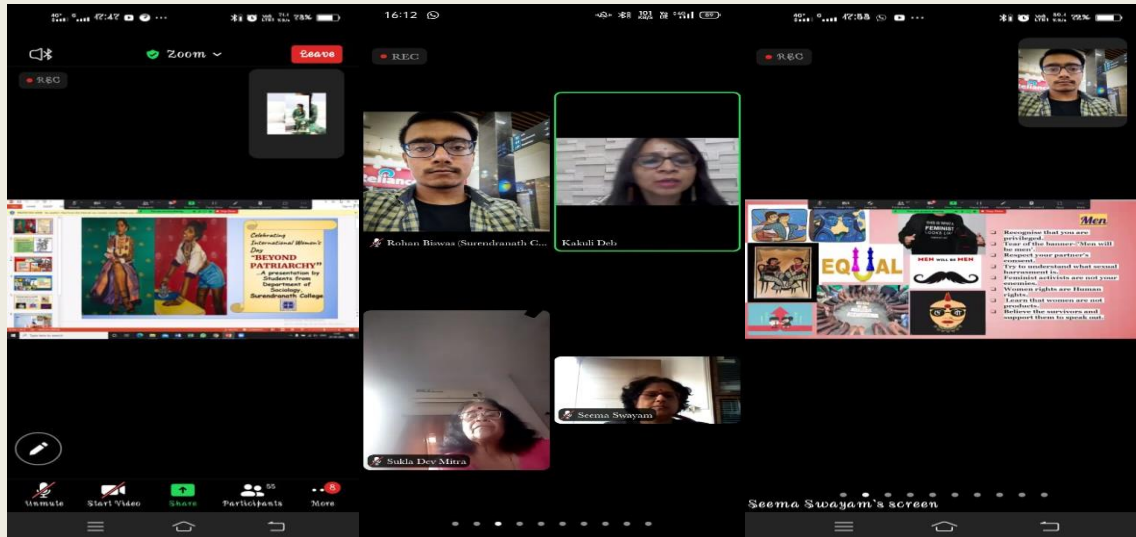
