

Programme Learning Outcomes (BA Hons. History)

- Students will be equipped with an extensive and deeper understanding of early Indian History and the tools required for recovering diverse historical aspects from a rich variety of sources.
- Interdisciplinary approach will enable them to trace continuity and change in India spanning over several millennia.
- Emphasis on historiography will give them a perception of how our present knowledge has interpreted the past, the complexity of human existence. At the same time they will know that the pace and nature of change varied in different parts of the world.
- They would be able to differentiate the medieval from the classical and capitalist world. It would dawn upon them that these periods were not seen simultaneously throughout the world and even features were not uniform everywhere.
- Their skills thinking analyzing and evaluating historical information from multiple sources would develop.
- They themselves would learn and feel encouraged to document, collect, exhibit visual and material remains of the past.
- Their interest and analytical reasoning would help them to make meaningful choices regarding career and indentify employability options after completion of graduate program in History.
